BILLY SIMON SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The Billy Simon Scholarship Tournament will be open to all GSAUSBC youth members (in good standing) 6th grade and up.. This is a handicapped tournament.
2. Four (4) \$500 and four (4) \$250 scholarships shall be given – Girl’s and Boy’s handicap and scratch division. It is to be an educational award for college, business or trade school. **PARTICIPANTS WILL QUALIFY IN THE DIVISION WHERE THEY PLACE THE HIGHEST – HANDICAP OR SCRATCH, BOYS AND GIRLS (HANDICAP WILL TAKE PRECEDENCE).** In the case of a tie, there will be a one (1) game roll-off to determine the winner. Prize Fund will be returned 100%.
3. The entrant must list all leagues, bowling centers and averages in which any league bowling is done.
4. Entering averages for the tournament will be as follows (only GSAUSBC yearbook averages will be used):
 - a. Highest 08-09 yearbook average unless the current season’s average of 21 or more games (**as of April 18, 2010**) is 10 pins or more higher than the yearbook average.
 - b. If no previous yearbook average, the highest current league average as of April 18, 2010 for 21 or more games, will be used.
 - c. Entrants not having a 08-09 yearbook average or current league average as of April 18, 2010 for 21 or more games, will use the highest average for 21 or more games as of date of participation and **WRITTEN VERIFICATION OF AVERAGE (COPY OF STANDING SHEET) MUST BE FURNISHED TO THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR BEFORE BOWLING.**
 - d. All others will bowl scratch. Scratch average is 210.
5. **HANDICAP shall be 90% of 210.**
6. Contestants will bowl five (5) games across ten (10) lanes.
7. Participants must check in one-half (1/2) hour before scheduled time to bowl.
8. There will be NO consumption of alcoholic beverages or tobacco products by GSAUSBC youth members during tournament competition. Parents and spectators may not consume alcoholic beverages behind the lanes where the youth bowlers are bowling.
9. **DRESS CODE: SHORTS MUST BE LONG ENOUGH THAT THE BOWLER’S FINGERTIPS DO NOT TOUCH SKIN WHEN THEIR ARMS ARE EXTENDED DOWN TO THEIR SIDE. NO MINISKIRTS, LOW-CUT BLOUSES, SEE-THRU BLOUSES, CROP TOPS OR SLEEVELESS TOPS. NO HEADWEAR OF ANY TYPE WILL BE WORN DURING TOURNAMENT COMPETITION. PANTS MUST BE WORN IN AN APPROPRIATE MANNER SO THAT UNDERGARMENTS DO NOT SHOW. FINAL DECISION ON ATTIRE WILL BE MADE BY THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR.**
