Double Oaks Shootout Tournament Rules

1. The **Double Oaks Shootout** will be open to all **USBC Youth Certified MEMBERS**. (in good standing)(#04236)
2. This will be a singles tournament.
3. There will be two (2) divisions – Girls and Boys handicap divisions. The Scratch Division is combined boys and girls.
4. **Format:** Bowlers will bowl four (4) games across eight (8) lanes at 9:00 AM at Thousand Oaks Bowl. Then at 1:00 PM bowlers will bowl four (4) games across eight (8) lanes at Oak Hills Lanes.
5. Entry fee will be \$45.00. Lane fees are \$16.00, expenses are \$1.00, \$10 will be split between the Top 20 and Linda Quayle Tournaments and \$18.00 will go to the prize fund from each entry.. No entry fees will be returned. An extra \$10 will be charged for walk-in entries. The walk-in fee will be charged on September 18.
6. Optional Scratch Division: \$10
7. Prize fund will be awarded 100% in the form of scholarships and/or trophies based on a 1 in 10 ratio.
8. All scholarship prizes will be reported to Scholarship Management Accounting Reports for Tenpins (SMART) for disbursement. (SMART ACCT. #: 10578)
9. Entering averages for the tournament will be as follows:
 - A. Highest 10-11 yearbook average.
 - B. If no previous yearbook average, the highest current league average as of May 31, 2011, of 21 or more games will be used. **WRITTEN VERIFICATION OF AVERAGE (COPY OF STANDING SHEET) MUST BE FURNISHED TO THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR BEFORE BOWLING**
 - C. 2011 Summer averages of 12 or more games may be used if none of the above. **WRITTEN VERIFICATION OF AVERAGE. (COPY OF STANDING SHEET) MUST BE FURNISHED TO THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR BEFORE BOWLING**
 - D. All others will bowl scratch.
 - E. **FALSE INFORMATION IS SUBJECT TO AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION.**
10. **HANDICAP** shall be 90% of 210.
11. There will be **NO** consumption of alcoholic beverages or tobacco products by USBC members during tournament competition. Parents and spectators may not consume alcoholic beverages behind the lanes where USBC bowlers are bowling.
12. **JUNIOR GOLD QUALIFIER:** An extra \$40 will be charged to enter the Qualifier. The winner(s) will be determined by total pins after the 8 games. Separate divisions (boy & girl) will be offered if the boys division has at least five entries and the girls division has at least four entries. If either division doesn't have the minimum entries required, the divisions will be combined. The advancement ratio will be 1:6 with a major fraction thereof. Participants in the Junior Gold qualifier must be Junior Gold members and must show their Junior Gold membership cards. Junior Gold membership and/or renewal cards may be purchased at the tournament before bowling begins. Membership into the Junior Gold Program is \$30.00
13. **DRESS CODE:** Shorts must be long enough that the bowler's fingertips do not touch skin when their arms are extended down to their side. No miniskirts, low-cut blouses, see-thru blouses, crop tops or sleeveless tops. Clothing depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, guns or obscene gestures is not allowed. Final decision on attire will be made by the tournament director.
14. Unsportsmanlike conduct including but not limited to; striking ball returns or house equipment, fighting, offensive language or gestures, cheating, failure to abide by tournament or USBC rules, etc. could result in **immediate disqualification** and forfeiture of fees paid.
15. USBC TOURNAMENT RULES SHALL APPLY.
