*****TOURNAMENT RULES*****

1. To be eligible for this tournament, bowlers must be certified thru Greater San Antonio USBC. In addition, bowlers must have a permanent home mailing address within the geographical boundaries of Greater San Antonio USBC. Due to NCAA rules regarding scholarships, bowlers who are members of a bowling team at an NCAA school are ineligible for this tournament.
2. Bowlers will bowl six (6) games across 6 pair of lanes, moving one pair to the right after each game.
3. Four (4) \$350 and four (4) \$150 scholarships shall be given – Two divisions of girls for handicap and two divisions of boys (based on average). In addition, there will be a scratch division for those who want to enter. There will be an additional entry fee of \$10.00 for the scratch division. The award for the scratch division will be the total of all the \$10.00 entries without any expenses taken out. The tournament will guarantee a minimum of \$100 for the scratch winner. Plaques or scholarships will be awarded based on 1 in 10 entries in each division.
4. **NO WALK-IN ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
5. This tournament will consist of two (2) classes for boys and two (2) classes for girls, based on average (Girls A Division will be 130 & above and Girls B Division will be 129 & below. Boys A Division will be 150 and above and Boys B Division will be 149 & below.
6. All participants must check in **FORTY-FIVE (45) MINUTES** before squad.
7. **Entering averages for the tournament will be as follows: {a} highest 10-11 GSAUSBC Yearbook average, unless the current season's league average for 15 games or more as of 31 October 2011, is ten {10} pins higher than the Yearbook average; {b} if no 10-11 GSAUSBC Yearbook average, the highest current league average for 15 games or more as of 31 October 2011, will be used. All others will bowl scratch. Average adjustments may be made at the option of the tournament manager. Entries with average adjustments, with request, will be refunded.**
8. Entry closing date is **November 1, 2011**. Entry form and fees must be submitted to the tournament director by that date. Entry Fee is \$30.00 per entry or \$40.00 per entry if bowler enters optional scratch event. **Checks are to be made payable to GSAUSBC.**
9. There will be NO consumption of alcoholic beverages or tobacco products by Youth members while participating in competition. Spectators must keep alcoholic beverages and tobacco products in center designated area.
10. Proper attire must be worn. Sleeveless shirts or blouses, low-cut blouses, midriff tops, see-through blouses, caps, hats, headphones, radios, or video games will **NOT** be allowed. **SHORTS ARE ALLOWED BUT MUST NOT BE SO SHORT AS TO ALLOW THE BOWLER TO TOUCH SKIN WHEN ARMS ARE EXTENDED TO THEIR SIDE. PANTS MUST BE WORN IN AN APPROPRIATE MANNER SO THAT UNDERGARMENTS DO NOT SHOW. Final decision on attire will be made by tournament director and committee.**
11. Kicking ball returns, intentional fouling or other conduct detrimental to the best interest of the tournament and bowling, either on or off the lanes will result in **DISQUALIFICATION** by tournament director and committee.
12. **NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE RETURNED OR REFUNDED.**
13. In case of a tie, there will be a one {1} game roll-off.
14. **HANDICAP will be 90% of 210 for all bowlers.**
15. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director and committee no later than 30 minutes after completion of the tournament. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament committee.
16. **Scholarship funds will be submitted to the SMART Program (Acct #9772), 621 Six Flags Drive, Arlington, TX 76011 within 30 days after the completion of the tournament.**
17. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the tournament director and committee. All USBC tournament rules will apply.
18. Only contestants and Tournament Officials will be allowed in settee area. **FOUL LIGHTS WILL BE FUNCTIONING. NO FLASH CAMERAS.**
19. Award fees will be returned 100% in the form of scholarships and/or plaques.
