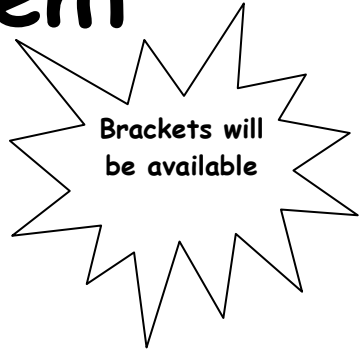

Linda Quayle Scholarship Tournament Rules

1. The **Linda Quayle Memorial Scholarship Tournament** will be open to all **USBC Youth Certified MEMBERS** (in good standing). (#04682)
2. This will be a singles tournament. Participants may enter in one (1) division only, but may enter that division as many times as they want (space permitting). A bowler may not place more than once.
3. There will be four (4) divisions – Girl's and Boy's scratch and handicap divisions. If there are not enough entries for a division, the bowler will be given the option of entering another division.
4. **Qualifying:** Contestants will bowl four (4) games across eight (8) lanes. 1 in 8 will qualify for the semi-finals. Pin count will carry over to the semi-finals. In the case of a tie, there will be a 9th and 10th frame roll-off.
5. **Semi-Finals:** Bowlers will bowl 3 games. The top 5 bowlers in each division will advance to the finals. In the case of a tie, there will be a 9th and 10th frame roll-off. The lanes will be re-oiled before the semi-finals.
6. **Finals:** Format will be stair step.
7. **Entry fee** will be \$40.00 per shift. Lane fees are \$8.00, expenses are \$2.00, and \$30.00 will go to the prize fund from each entry. Marathon entries will be \$150.00. No entry fees will be returned. Walk-in entry fee will be \$50.00 per shift and \$160.00 for marathon. The walk-in fee will be charged on October 15 & 16.
8. Prize fund will be awarded 100% in the form of scholarships and/or trophies based on a 1 in 8 ratio.
9. All scholarship prizes will be reported to Scholarship Management Accounting Reports for Tenpins (SMART) for disbursement. (SMART ACCT. #: 10578)
10. Entering averages for the tournament will be as follows:
 - A. Highest 10-11 yearbook average.
 - B. If no previous yearbook average, the highest current league average as of October 1, 2011 of 12 or more games will be used. **WRITTEN VERIFICATION OF AVERAGE (COPY OF STANDING SHEET). MUST BE FURNISHED TO THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR BEFORE BOWLING**
 - C. All others will bowl scratch.
 - D. **FALSE INFORMATION IS SUBJECT TO AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFICATION.**
11. **HANDICAP** shall be 90% of 210.
12. There will be **NO** consumption of alcoholic beverages or tobacco products by USBC members during tournament competition. Parents and spectators may not consume alcoholic beverages behind the lanes where USBC bowlers are bowling.
13. **DRESS CODE:** Shorts must be long enough that the bowler's fingertips do not touch skin when their arms are extended down to their side. No miniskirts, low-cut blouses, see-thru blouses, crop tops or sleeveless tops. Clothing depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, guns or obscene gestures is not allowed. Final decision on attire will be made by the tournament director.
14. Two separate Junior Gold qualifiers will be held. One qualifier will be two squads on Saturday and the second qualifier will be the two squads on Sunday (qualifier consists of 8 games). Separate divisions (boy & girl) will be offered if the boys division has at least five entries and the girls division has at least four entries. If either division doesn't have the minimum entries required, the divisions will be combined. The advancement ratio will be 1:6 with a major fraction thereof. Participants in the Junior Gold qualifier must be Junior Gold members and must show their Junior Gold membership cards. Junior Gold membership and/or renewal cards may be purchased at the tournament before bowling begins. Membership into the Junior Gold Program is \$30.00.
15. Unsportsmanlike conduct including but not limited to; striking ball returns or house equipment, fighting, offensive language or gestures, cheating, failure to abide by tournament or USBC rules, etc. could result **in immediate disqualification** and forfeiture of fees paid.

Second Chance Division \$ 35

This is a separate division open to those not making the Semi-Finals. Three (3) games will be bowled to determine the winner. It will be divided into Handicap & Scratch Divisions. 100% of the entry from the Second Chance Division will be given as scholarship. There will be two (2) divisions based handicap and scratch. Prize fund will be determined by number of entries. There will not be separate divisions for males and females.
