# Summer Blast Youth-Adult Tournament

## Tournament Rules

1. The **Summer Blast Youth-Adult Tournament** will be open to all **USBC Certified MEMBERS** (in good standing).
2. This will be a doubles tournament. Team will consist of one youth bowler and one adult bowler. A youth may enter with more than one adult. (one entry per squad) The youth may only qualify for finals one (1) time and will bowl the finals with the adult they qualified the highest.
3. There will be one (1) division.
4. **Qualifying:** Teams will bowl three (3) games across six (6) lanes.
5. **Finals:** The top 8 teams will compete in a double elimination bracket with the winner of the bracket declared the champion. The format will be the Baker System. The adult will bowl in frames 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 and the youth will bowl 2, 4, 6, 8, and 10. In the case of a tie for the top 8, there will be a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll-off. Finals will begin after the last squad has finished.
6. Entry fee will be \$45.00 per team. Lane fees are \$12.00, \$5.00 to the Linda Quayle Memorial Scholarship Tournament, and \$28.00 will go to the prize fund from each entry. No entry fees will be returned.
7. Reserve entries are due by July 22nd. **Additional entries will be accepted (space available) after July 22<sup>nd</sup> and will be charged an extra \$5.00.** Re-entries will not be charged the extra \$5.00.
8. Prize fund will be awarded 100% in the form of scholarships and/or trophies based on a **1 in 8** ratio.
9. All scholarship prizes will be reported to Scholarship Management Accounting Reports for Tenpins (SMART) for disbursement. (SMART ACCT. # 10880)
10. Entering averages for the tournament will be as follows:
  - A. Highest 09-10 yearbook average.
  - B. If no previous yearbook average, the highest current league average as of May 31, 2011, of 21 or more games will be used. **WRITTEN VERIFICATION OF AVERAGE (COPY OF STANDING SHEET). MUST BE FURNISHED TO THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR BEFORE BOWLING**
  - C. 2010 Summer averages of 12 or more games may be used if none of the above. **WRITTEN VERIFICATION OF AVERAGE (COPY OF STANDING SHEET). MUST BE FURNISHED TO THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR BEFORE BOWLING**
  - D. All others will bowl scratch.
  - E. **SEE RULE 319 FOR REPORTING AVERAGES.**
11. **HANDICAP** shall be 90% of 210.
12. **ADULTS ONLY:** Rules 319A-2, 319D and 319E are waived.
13. There will be **NO** consumption of alcoholic beverages or tobacco products by USBC members during tournament competition. Parents and spectators may not consume alcoholic beverages behind the lanes where USBC bowlers are bowling.
14. **HIGH GAME & SERIES SIDEPOTS:** Cost: \$10. High game will be paid \$2 per entry every game and \$4 per entry for high series. There will be 2 divisions: Scratch & Handicap.
15. **DRESS CODE:** Shorts must be long enough that the bowler's fingertips do not touch skin when their arms are extended down to their side. No miniskirts, low-cut blouses, see-thru blouses, crop tops or sleeveless tops. Clothing depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, guns or obscene gestures is not allowed. No headwear of any type will be worn during tournament competition. Final decision on attire will be made by the tournament director.
16. Unsportsmanlike conduct including but not limited to; striking ball returns or house equipment, fighting, offensive language or gestures, cheating, failure to abide by tournament or USBC rules, etc. could result in **immediate disqualification** and forfeiture of fees paid.
17. USBC TOURNAMENT RULES SHALL APPLY.
