***** TOURNAMENT RULES *****

1. This is a HANDICAP TOURNAMENT. Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference between bowler's average and 210. This tournament is open to all current season USBC youth members of the Greater San Antonio USBC Association. High School bowlers not members of GSAUSBC must pay a \$5 participation fee.
2. TEAMS will consist of (4) members, boys, girls or mixed. DOUBLES will be two members. SINGLES are divided into divisions: Boys to be classified in four (4) divisions; girls in three (3) divisions in both SINGLES and ALL EVENTS. TEAMS and DOUBLES will each be divided into four (4) divisions regardless of gender make-up.
3. Divisions will be determined by an equal percentage of total entries. Team, Doubles, Boys Singles and Boys All Events will have approximately 20% of the total entrants in each division. Girls Singles and Girls All Events will have approximately 25% of total entrants in each division.
4. Bowlers may enter SINGLES/DOUBLES events only once. Bowlers entering Singles or Doubles must enter both. Bowlers may enter team event more than once but only two from the original team may bowl together (first team event score will count for all events).
5. All participants must check in ONE HOUR (60 minutes) before squad. Substitutes must check in ONE HOUR before bowling. (If a bowler is replaced by the coach and the substitute has bowled the first practice ball in the tournament, the substitute will not be taken out).
6. The LINE-UP on the entry form will be the OFFICIAL LINE-UP and will not be changed except for substitutions (subs must take LINE-UP position of the bowler they are replacing). BOWLERS NAMES MUST BE THE SAME AS IT APPEARS ON THEIR CARDS.
7. **Entering averages for the tournament will be as follows (only GSAUSBC league averages will be used): (a) highest 10-11 YEARBOOK average, unless the current season's (league) average for twenty one (21) games or more is ten (10) pins higher than the YEARBOOK average, as of December 31, 2011; (b) if no 10-11 YEARBOOK average then the highest current league average as of December 31, 2011, fifteen (15) or more games will be used; (IF RULE (A) OR (B) DOES NOT APPLY, BOWLER MAY USE HIGHEST AVERAGE OF 15 GAMES OR MORE AS OF THE ENTRY CLOSING DATE (OR DATE OF PARTICIPATION)); (c) all others bowl SCRATCH. Average adjustments may be made at the option of the tournament manager. Entries with average adjustments, with request, will be refunded.**
8. DRESS CODE: Sleeveless shirts, miniskirts, low-cut blouses, see-through blouses, midriff shirts, caps and hats will not be allowed. Shorts & skirts are allowed; however, they must be long enough so that their fingers do not touch skin when their arms are extended down to their sides. No shirts with derogatory or offensive words or pictures or shirts depicting tobacco and/or alcohol will be allowed. **PANTS MUST BE WORN IN AN APPROPRIATE MANNER SO THAT UNDERGARMENTS DO NOT SHOW. FINAL DECISION ON ATTIRE WILL BE MADE BY THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR.**
9. No food or drink will be allowed in the settee area. NO SMOKING, USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS, OR CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY THE PARTICIPANTS WILL BE ALLOWED ONCE TOURNAMENT COMPETITION HAS BEGUN. SPECTATORS MUST KEEP ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND TOBACCO PRODUCTS IN CENTER DESIGNATED AREA.
10. Kicking ball returns, intentional fouling or conduct detrimental to the best interest of the tournament and bowling, either on or off the lanes will not be tolerated and could result in DISQUALIFICATION by tournament director.
11. AWARD FEES will be returned 100% in awards (one for every ten [10] entries in each class).
12. NO ENTRY FEE WILL BE RETURNED OR REFUNDED.
13. "SPECIAL AWARDS" – A bowler is limited to one individual award. (ALL EVENTS, HIGH SERIES, or HIGH GAME in each division [in that order]).
14. SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS: \$125 to each of the four (4) City Champions (All Events, Scratch & Handicap, Boy & Girl); \$50 scholarship to each of the All Events Winners; \$50 scholarship to each of the seven (7) Singles Division Winners; the first place team in each division will receive a total of \$200 scholarships (each member will receive \$50 scholarship); the first place doubles team in each division will receive a total of \$100 scholarships (each bowler will receive \$50 scholarship). TOTAL AMOUNT FOR SCHOLARSHIPS TO BE AWARDED WILL BE OVER \$2,400. SCHOLARSHIPS WILL BE MANAGED BY THE USBC SMART PROGRAM (Acct #9210).
15. ONLY CONTESTANTS and TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS WILL BE ALLOWED IN SETTEE AREA.
16. **OPTIONAL JUNIOR GOLD QUALIFER:** There will be a Junior Gold qualifier held in conjunction with this tournament. (minimum of five (5) bowlers required to hold the qualifier) . The fee for the JG Gold qualifier will be \$40. This fee is in addition to the tournament entry fee. The JG Gold qualifier entry fee may be paid with the tournament entry fees or may be paid on date of participation, but must be paid before announcements for their shift begins. Bowlers must be Junior Gold members or purchase membership (\$30) at the tournament. Junior Gold members must show their membership card. The optional Junior Gold portion will use their 3 game scratch score. Each weekends high place boy and girl Junior Gold entrant (subject to 5 girls and 5 boys minimum per weekend for separate divisions) will receive the Junior Gold spot. Entries will be awarded on a ratio of 1:5 entries or major fraction thereof each weekend. Bowlers may enter the Junior Gold event once each weekend, as each weekend is conducted as an entirely separate qualifier.
